

Intermediate Security Analyst

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Intermediate Security Analyst ideal candidate will assist the IHS CISO in providing technical support of all Recovery Act funded IT security initiatives as provided by HHS Recovery Act initiatives pertaining to the IHS. The ideal candidate will have at a minimum the required experience as follows:

- Demonstrated, in-depth knowledge consistent with security principles and best practices as reflected in various Federal legislation, NIST guidance, and industry best practices
- Specialized security training and certifications appropriate for their area of expertise, e.g., a current Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP) or similar security or program management certifications.
- Experience in providing services to a federal customer within the scope of the contract
- Familiarity with HIPPA standards (is a plus).

As an onsite representative of the company, candidate must possess effective communication and interpersonal skills to build and maintain effective working relationships with the client.

Education: BS degree in Computer Science, or equivalent experience, in Information Management, or related field.

Experience: Two (2) to Five (5) years experience with increasing responsibilities Security Analyst responsibilities.
